



#### Values for Brookings FUMC

I have just completed four years as pastor of Brookings FUMC. This has been a happy adventure, filled with challenges and opportunities spiritual growth. As I reflect on my time spent with our members, I have discerned the following as values that are believed and practiced by our members:

**Welcome:** All are welcome in our church. "Open Hearts, Open Minds, Open Doors" is to be found on the entrance of our buildings. This welcome also insists that each person who is welcomed should in turn be willing to show the same welcome to other people.

**Service:** We are a community called to serve our community. For this reason, we have a Community Life Center and employ a Director to drive outreach. We serve Harvest Table, and we give away diapers, and we participate in Souperbowl of Caring, the Feeding Brookings Thanksgiving meal, Sleep in Heavenly Peace, and Solar Ovens.

**Teaching:** This church places a high value on teaching: we employ an Education Director, we run classes and courses, and the pastor is expected to read and teach. This church intentionally promotes thoughtful, reflective Christian teaching.

**Diversity:** We are a church that embraces a variety of people, ranging in ages from young children to the elderly in wheelchairs, from the academically educated to those who have learned from the hard knocks of life, and people of all political and social opinions. This is expressed in a variety of expressions of worship, in a range of opportunities to offer service, and in our willingness to try anything that will promote the love of Jesus.


